In the last few months we have been concentrating on drifting for Pollack and this Spring has been harder work than some past seasons, on some days the fish have just not played ball, mostly this has been when shoals of Sprats have shown over a wreck on the Sounder.

The good news was that when we contacted Pollack they were mainly a good size and we saw the biggest Pollack for 4 years when Louis Rogers brought on board a fish just over 20 lbs, on his first sea fishing trip. The favourite lure has again been black/pink tailed jelly worms,

closely followed by Sidewinder shads and on one day all they would take was yellow lures!

THE COD HAVE ARRIVED!

Cod are now showing on the wrecks and judging by our improving catches over the past few years, this year should show some bumper catches!



We have just seen the first shoals of Mackerel on our favourite mackerel spot, just outside the Marina - the best bait for big Bass and Conger.
