ICE BOX

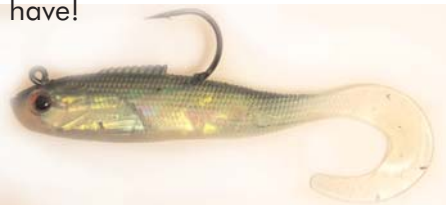

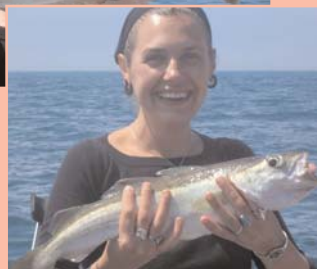
