You can also now pay deposits by Paypal on the shop section as well as purchase our new Beaufort Charters Fleece!!

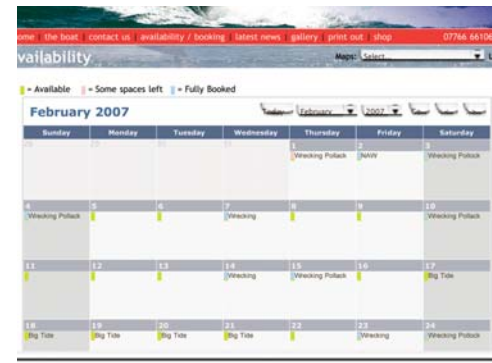

CORPORATE CHARTERS

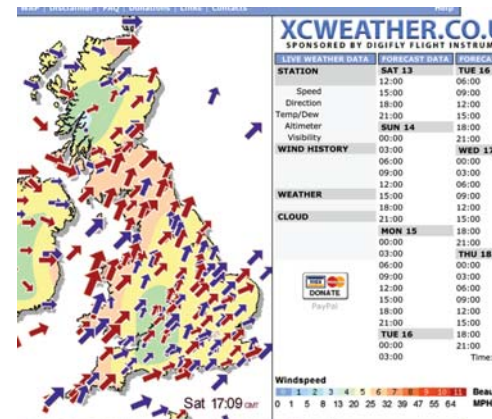

Phil Hambly - Sales and Marketing Director of Rocom said " *It was a great day, very well organised and really nice to meet you all in a relaxed social environment*"

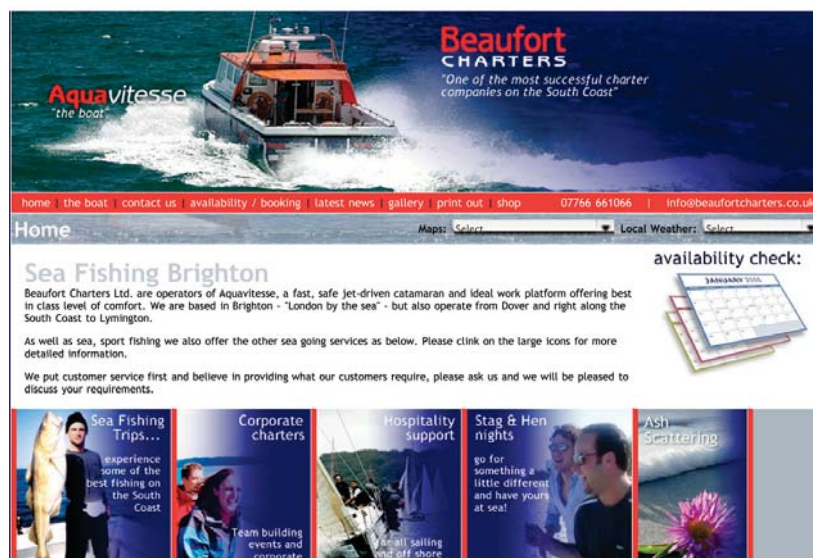
