This is always kept up to date and our Mix and Match days are where we put together a trip from individuals or small parties and is proving popular. Please use it.

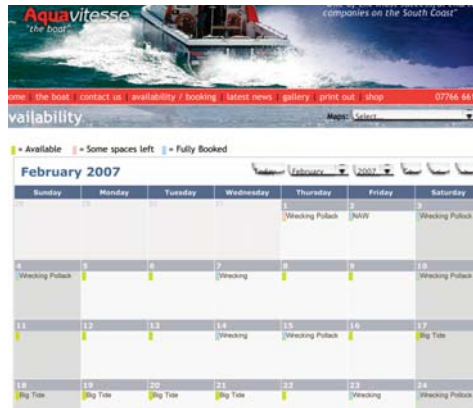
